INTERNATIONAL SCIENCE PROGRAM WITH INDUSTRIAL MANAGEMENT SKILL

Who can take iSC - TU?

ISC-TU is designed to be taught as a four year course for undergraduate students, suitable for a major in Science. The candidate must complete high school (M.6 or Grade 12) with a certificate or its equivalent as issued by the Ministry of Education, Thailand.

Applicants must demonstrate English competence with one of the following test results;

- TOEFL (IBT) = 50 or (paper-based) = 460 or above
- IELTS (academic band) = 4.5 or above
- TU-Get = 450 or above

Subjects on offer

Faculty of Science and Technology offers Bachelor of Science Program in Industrial Science and Management with three majors:

- **Biotechnology**
- **Applied Chemistry**
- **Food Science and Technology**

Each major has its own core and industrial-oriented courses of 32 credits from total of 139 credits. Respectively, there are 30 credits of general education offered by Thammasat University throughout four year course.

In the **first year**, courses are mainly **Mathematics & Science education**.

In the **second year**, students will enter the major that is most appropriate for them, finalized by their GPA and announced by ISC committee. There are **Management & Industrial-Oriented Courses** of 18 credits also arranged by ISC-TU throughout four year course for students in all majors to study together

In the **third year**, there is a choice between core and extended curricula in each major. Students will spend no less than 180 hours during summer on a **Field Training** to gain valuable industry experience by doing hands-on work solving private or public sector challenges.

In the **fourth year**, courses are focused on **Professional Skill & Training courses** of 8 credits with Presentation Skill for Industrial Sciences and Management Seminar and Special Problems in Sciences and Technology.

What documents are required for application?

Applicant must apply Online only and scan all documents in pdf files and ready for upload in application process. The original documents must be available for the interview

- Latest official high school transcript (*with English translation for overseas students*)
- Photograph 1"x1" (*wearing uniform if possible*)
- Official report of English Proficiency Test (*At least 2 years validity until the interview date*)
 - TOEFL (IBT) = 50 or (paper-based) = 460 or above or
 - IELTS (academic band) = 4.5 or above or
 - TU-Get = 450 or above
- Photocopy of official identification document (*ID card*) or passport (*for oversea students*)
- Photocopy of official house registration (*Thai students only*)
- Statement of purpose no more than 500 words or A4
- Photocopy of Application Fee 500 Baht/ US\$15
the application fee is 500 Baht (or US\$ 15) paid via SCB using our pay-slip provided after the completing Online application process. Please, fax or scan and e-mail to us after making the payment (for successful application, one must pay within final date of each application round).
- Official report of Science Proficiency Test* (*optional*)
 - Scholastic Aptitude Test (SAT) or
 - International Baccalaureate (IB) Diploma or
 - 6th Form or 7th Form or NCEA or NZQA or
 - International General Certificate of Secondary Education (IGCSE) or
General Certificate of Secondary Education (GCSE) or
 - National Test Scores (O-NET, GAT, PAT 1 and PAT 2)

The fee is charged per credit; please refer to the list below for the subject fees:

Application fee :	500 Baht (US\$ 15)
Administration fees:	24,000 Baht/Semester (US\$ 800)
Registration fee :	Approx. 5,960 Baht/Semester (US\$ 200)
Tuition fees:	2,400 Baht/Lecture Credit (US\$ 80)
	3,400 Baht/Lab Credit (US\$ 110)

The tuition and registration fees are approximately 150,000 baht/year, and roughly 600,000 baht per 4-year-course. The actual amount depends on number of credits registered in each semester. These fees are not included living expenses and accommodation.
